

DRESS CODE

Dress Appropriately (this is not a sex camp)

Do not wear tank tops that show cleavage. Sports bras should be worn under any low cut shirts.

Do not show your stomach. Shirts must be long enough to cover your torso while doing any kind of movement.

Do not wear short shores aka daisy dukes. When you are standing up straight with your arms at your sides, your shorts should not come above your middle finger. If they do, they are inappropriate for rehearsal.

Wear Clothes that Fit You

Make sure any pants worn to rehearsal do not go past your ankles. It is dangerous for you, as you could slip on the material when marching. It also makes it impossible for the staff to correct your feet.

Shoes
